

# LAUREL MOUNTAIN CHRISTIAN CAMP

## Overview of Job Descriptions

**Cabin Counselors:** We are looking for men and women who have finished at least one year of college and have a deep love for Jesus Christ that shines most brightly when they are playing, serving, and working with children. LMCC campers require the kind of loving attention that recognizes their unique identity and place in God's Kingdom, calls forth their strengths and gifts, engages their imaginations in an outdoor setting, and provides a safe and nurturing environment in which they can thrive. Cabin counselors have responsibility, along with their co-counselor, for approximately 8-10 campers, as well as participating whole-heartedly in all camp activities.

**Head Counselors:** We are looking for a man and a woman, with residential camp experience, recognized and exercised gifts in discipleship and/or spiritual mentoring, and a great love for Jesus; who will invest in LMCC's college-age staff throughout the camp season. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: mentoring individual staff for ongoing spiritual development, leadership of staff prayer and Bible study, leadership in ongoing training events, assistance with camp program and supervision.

**Arts & Crafts Director:** We are looking for a man or woman who has finished at least one year of college and whose love for Jesus Christ is most clearly seen in teaching and creating art with children ages 8 – 14. This individual needs to have teaching experience -most preferably in the arts, as well as confidence in classroom management. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: design and organization of weekly arts and crafts activities that are age appropriate and thematically connected; ability to facilitate small and large groups of children; organization of resources; assistance in ongoing staff training and camp program.

**Crew Director:** We are looking for a man and a woman with residential camp experience, recognized and exercised gifts in leadership and/or discipleship, and a passionate love for Jesus who are willing to invest their time and energy into a high school work Crew. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: mentoring Crew for ongoing spiritual development including daily/weekly Bible study, coordinating kitchen and maintenance Crew work schedules, overseeing all work projects, motivating staff, assisting in ongoing staff training and camp program as directed.

**Adventure Director:** We are looking for a man or woman with residential camp experience who loves the Lord and has a passion for the great outdoors. This individual must have experience facilitating adventure activities such as: hiking, fishing, canoeing, rock climbing and challenge courses. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: Training staff in the facilitation, safety, risk management, and emergency procedures for each of our outdoor elements; planning age-appropriate formatted hikes including but not limited to: creek-walks, wetlands study, tree identification, gardening, and orienteering, while aligning the formatted hikes with the camp theme; overall participation in camp activities as directed.

**Videographer:** We are looking for a man or woman who has finished at least one year of college who is in a growing relationship with Jesus Christ and who understands the visual arts as they both reflect and interpret the Christian camp experience. Proficient use of a digital camera, video camera and Mac are a must. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: producing weekly and end of summer camp videos that capture and reflect the summer's Biblical theme; provide high quality photographs to be used for future camp promotional materials; and generally acting as a resource for programming as it relates to the visual arts and media.

**Crew:** We are looking for responsible high schoolers who know and love the Lord and are interested in participating in the ministry of LMCC through servant-leadership. Prior work experience is helpful, but not necessary. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: preparation, serving and clean-up of meals; housekeeping, such as cleaning bathrooms or washing laundry; general maintenance as directed; assistance with set-up or leading of group games; participation in daily Bible study; enthusiastic participation in other areas of camp program as directed.

**Lifeguards:** We are looking for men or women who have a relationship with Christ who love being in and around water. These individuals maintain an atmosphere of safety and fun at both the pool and lake. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: overseeing the safety of campers and staff during pool time or canoeing activities; cleaning pool and filters; recording pool readings; communicating with the Property Manager about water quality; teaching swimming lessons to staff and campers as necessary; participating in other camp programming as directed.
